All supplies are able to be purchased locally in Austin at Jerry's Artarama

Paint colors:

Gamblin Artists' Oils are an excellent artist grade paint that I recommend. Buy 37 ml tubes except for the Titanium White-Alkyd, which should be 150ml.

The most important thing is to try to get the listed paint colors as this is the artist's recommended palette.

I do *not* recommend most of the Charvin paints that Jerry's sells, especially the student grade. In my experience they are too inconsistent and have more fillers in them.
